Description

This painting depicts a spectacular view of the Verdon Gorge, characterized by its steep cliffs and turquoise waters. The composition is structured by a play of rocky masses framing the river, creating a marked sense of depth. The brushwork is thick and expressive, applied with a palette knife in places, lending relief and movement to the paint. The palette, dominated by mineral tones, greens, and blues, sensitively captures the light and ruggedness of the Provençal landscape. The work follows in the tradition of 20th-century French landscape painting, with a Post-Impressionist approach that emphasizes texture, the vibrancy of color, and a sensitive interpretation of the subject rather than a strictly realistic depiction. François Marius Baron was born in Saint-Gervais-d'Auvergne; he studied
