



Six Silver Timbales Monogrammed "l.p." By Louis Tassin, Empire Period

Description

Set of six silver goblets or cups, each marked "L.P." by Louis Tassin , a Parisian silversmith active between 1803 and 1814 who specialized in the manufacture of goblets and cups.Slightly flared truncated cone shape, with a double beading on the rim. Engraved with "LP" between two small stylized arrows. Silversmith's hallmarks: LT, a mark, and a cannonball.First-title rooster hallmarks, Minerva medium-guarantee hallmarks, Greek woman's head guarantee hallmarks, and the letter P. Tassin, Louis, a Parisian silversmith active between 1803 and 1814, specializing in the manufacture of goblets and cups. Examples of his goblets on pedestals, featuring extensively engraved decorations, can be found in the commercial market and in some museum

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collections. A series of chalices, patens, and ciboria has also been attributed to him.
