Description

Pair of earthenware vases signed Keller & Guérin, late 19th-early 20th century. A superb pair of glazed earthenware vases, produced by the Keller & Guérin factory in Lunéville, circa 1880-1900. These vases feature rich Japanese-inspired decoration, characteristic of the enthusiasm for Art Nouveau and Japonism in Europe in the late 19th century. The design consists of stylized foliage and flowers in warm shades of brown and ochre, applied to a glossy background. This type of ornamentation, inspired by Japanese prints and Oriental ceramics, attests to the great refinement of the factory's productions during this period. A Japanese-style signature is visible beneath the base, confirming the Asian influence in the design of these pieces. The Lunéville factory, run by Keller & Guérin,
