The motifs of flowers, foliage, birds, and flowering branches unfold against a luminous ivory background, punctuated by shades of pink, red, blue, green, and beige. The design is framed by a wide, richly ornamented floral border, extended by botanical compositions that lend the rug remarkable decorative depth. The soft and elegant color palette, dominated by pastel tones and red accents, gives this piece a
