Set of 12 dessert plates by Haviland, from the Dammouse Collection. The Dammouse collection is a true ode to floral beauty and Orientalism. Inspired by Japanese prints and silks, its designs are distinguished by floral motifs enhanced with touches of gold, capturing the essence of a precious and delicate natural world. It bears the name of its creator, the talented designer Édouard Dammouse, and was inspired by a watercolor he painted for Haviland around 1880. A renowned painter and engraver, he joined the famous Atelier d'Auteuil in Paris, conceived by Haviland in the late 19th century. Like new condition
