



Bronze Spoon Mold With Medallion Decoration - 19th-century Craft Tool (circa 1900)

Description

This bronze mold was intended for casting molten pewter for the artisanal manufacture of spoons, featuring a reversed "Brun" mark that may correspond to a workshop or founder's name. Complete two-part bivalve assembly consisting of its two original parts (male and female) perfectly fitted, with a polished interior to facilitate the release of the pieces after casting. A fine, mysterious solid bronze object dating from the late 19th century, featuring an authentic medal patina and traces of manual shaping on the exterior: once assembled, try having your friends guess the function of these objects, and they will have a very hard time figuring it out (several of my antique dealer friends didn't find it...). Good state of preservation, without restoration or missing parts. Careful shipping via tracked parcel.
