Description

Venetian painter (19th century) - Venice, view of the Royal Gardens with the Coffee House facing the Basilica of Santa Maria della Salute. 15 x 23 cm (unframed) - 22 x 30 cm (framed). Tempera on paper, in a carved and gilded wooden frame. Inscribed on the back in pencil: "I giardini a Venezia - Giardini Reali ?". Small gouache view on paper depicting the Royal Gardens of Venice, seen from the tree-lined promenade running alongside the basin, with the Coffee House to the right and, in the background, the domes of the Basilica of Santa Maria della Salute. The composition is dominated by the row of trees and the balustrade along the canal, where gondolas and cargo boats are moored. The figures in the foreground, strolling along the promenade, recall the typical repertoire of Venetian view-painting

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staffage figures, a formula common among small souvenir paintings made for the nineteenth-century tourist market. The pencil inscription on the verso, «I giardini a Venezia - Giardini Reali?», confirms the identification of the subject.
