Scandinavian School. Alfred Broge. Oil on canvas, "The Little House by the Fjord," signed lower right "A. Broge." 23.4 × 30.6 cm. Danish School. On the back, on one of the stretcher bars, there are inscriptions indicating a location and an inventory number. Karl-Harald-Alfred Broge (1870-1955) studied at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts in Copenhagen under the guidance of landscape painter Rudolph Bissen (1846-1911). Associated with Danish Realism and Naturalism, the artist became known for his warm, light-filled interior scenes, as well as for his rural and seascapes. Broge regularly exhibited at the prestigious Charlottenborg Spring Exhibition in Copenhagen throughout his career. Our painting is a remarkable showcase of Alfred Broge's talent; he frequently painted the Roskilde
