SPECC581 - This mirror is a magnificent example of Baroque-Rococo style. The carved wooden frame is richly decorated with volutes, cartouches, and plant motifs, featuring gold leaf gilding that retains a beautiful, warm, and weathered patina. The openwork cornice, which is extremely striking, lends movement and lightness to the piece as a whole. Of particular interest is the engraved mirror at the top, depicting a romantic scene in the 18th-century style--a refined and uncommon feature. The lower section, with its more linear design, balances the decorative exuberance, making the piece harmonious and well-proportioned. Overall, it is a striking piece, ideal as a focal point in elegant and formal settings. 18th century. Dimensions: L 145 x H 203 cm
