Description

Bouquet of Flowers by Henri Jehin - 19th century. Painting on paper mounted under glass in a gilded wooden frame - Gouache enhanced with oil. This work of exceptional quality features a distinctive technique designed to create a lovely crackle effect in the paint on the flowers. Signed "Jehin-Turin 1872" in the foliage at the base of the bouquet. Henri JEHIN (1812-1880) : Belgian painter, musician, and artisan, born and died in Liège, primarily active in Spa. Specializing in still life painting, he made his own protective varnish, which was highly regarded for its excellent protection and luster. His works were exhibited in France, England, and Belgium. He won a medal in London in 1851, and again in Paris in 1855 and 1867. He was also appointed Official Supplier to the Court, notably to the
