César, César Baldaccini (1921-1998) Teapot, 1983, Ink and ink pencil. Signed in graphite, with a fingerprint, dated 1983, and inscribed "for Mossé and his little wife. With friendship." Dimensions: 29.5 x 21 cm. Provenance: Michelle Champetier Gallery Private collection, Lyon. Mr. Mossé was the artist's accountant. A recurring motif in César's work, the teapot transcends its status as a mere everyday object, a theme dear to the New Realists. Through it, the artist actually paints an intimate portrait of his mistress "Christine R.," who ran a tea room in Nice. Because of their "colorful" relationship, their mutual friends took to calling her "La Théière"
