Dating from circa 1780, it features a molded cornice above two short and six long, cockbeaded, graduated oak-lined drawers, all fitted with the original finely crafted brass swan-neck handles and escutcheons. The entire piece stands on its original tall, elegant bracket feet, giving it excellent presence and balanced proportions. The surface has never been stripped or refinished, resulting in a truly beautiful, untouched patina that has developed naturally over more than two centuries. The mahogany has acquired a rich depth of color, enhancing the

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warmth and grain of the wood--a defining characteristic of the finest Georgian furniture. Sturdy, strong, and ready for everyday use, it perfectly captures the relaxed refinement of the English country house style. Traditionally designed for storing sheets, clothing, and fine textiles, 18th-century chest-on-chests are highly sought after for their superior cabinetmaking, classic lines, and exceptional choice of materials. This example is no exception: it is a testament to first-rate Georgian craftsmanship and offers both practical storage and strong decorative impact. For ease of transport and installation, this tallboy separates into two sections, making it suitable for both period homes and modern interiors alike. A wonderfully original Georgian mahogany chest-on-chest, combining authenticity, elegance, and functionality--an ideal statement piece for any interior that values history, quality, and timeless style.
