Description

A lovely sketch of a building in Casablanca, dated 1936, by a female painter who had spent time in Morocco. Marcelle Grasset, born in Paris in 1910, is best known for her abstract drawings from the 1960s--which bridge the gap between lyrical abstraction and art brut--some of which are held in the collections of the Musée d'Art Moderne de la Ville de Paris. The painting is set in a molded oak frame from the 1930s; without the frame, it measures 34.5 x 29.2 cm.
