Description

This atmospheric marine seascape by Herman Van den Berghe beautifully captures the quiet majesty of early 20th-century maritime life. The composition features two vessels, one steam-powered, one sail, set against a misty horizon rendered in soft, layered blues and greys. The artist's brushwork evokes the shimmer of light on water and the subtle movement of waves, typical of Belgian Impressionist marine painting from around 1900-1920.

The carved giltwood frame complements the work's tonal harmony, its scrolling ornament lending a period authenticity. Minor wear to the gilding and edges is consistent with age, while the canvas and paint layer remain in good condition. The signature, visible lower right, reads Herman
