SABRE known as a Katana, signed by Kawachi no Kami Minamoto Hironobu Yamashiro and Kii Provinces, Japan Kanbu period (1661-1673) Steel, wood, lacquer, gold, shakudo, silver Nagasa: 68.4; Nakago: 22.3 cm; Sori: 1 cm Shinogi-tsukuri blade, mune takashi, gunome-style hamon. Kaeri-asashi-style boshi. Funa-gata nakago with kiri or kaku ichi monji; signed Kawachi no Kami Minamoto Hironobu below the jû-roku kiku (kiku mon), the kaye-mon (secondary crest) of the Ashi-kaga clan. Gilded daitsuki-niju-habaki. Wooden saya covered in black lacquer. Kojiri and koi guchi made of black-lacquered water buffalo horn. Kuri gata made of shakudo, chiseled with gold flowers. Sageo made of young bamboo with black speckles. Wooden tsuka ito, covered with

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shagreen, braided with beige silk.Fuchi and
kashira made of copper overlaid with shakudo,
engraved with flowers accented with
gold.Menuki depicting floral motifs.Iri mokko
tsuba made of copper overlaid with shakudo,
engraved with flowers, the entire piece accented
with silver, gold, and copper.Gilded, engraved
