Essential Parts For An Air Gun



Description

A case containing a compressed-airparlor pistol.The case is made of light oak. Its lid features arectangular brass plate on which the owner's name can be engraved.It closes with a hook, and a folding handle allows for easy transport.The inside of the lid is lined with a green velvetpadding. The bottom of the case, also lined with green velvet, has twocompartments: one for the pistol itself, the other for the compression key.A cardboard target is still inside the box.The pistol is made entirely of metal. The grip ischecked for a better grip. The frame is decorated withfoliage engravings. The breech and barrel are smooth. A smallfixed rear sight and front sight allow for aiming. A small movable breech allowsfor loading 4,5mm-caliber pellets. One side of the breech isengraved with "Brevet

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sgdg," the other with "Patent."The air compression tube and its pumping mechanism are housed within the stock. The tube is sealed by a spring-loaded cap, which is unscrewed and screwed back on using the two studs on the key. The wrench supplied with the pistol has, on one end, the pins for removing the stock cap, and on the other, the pumping wrench. This set is in excellent working condition and presentation. Nearly 100% of the nickel plating remains.
