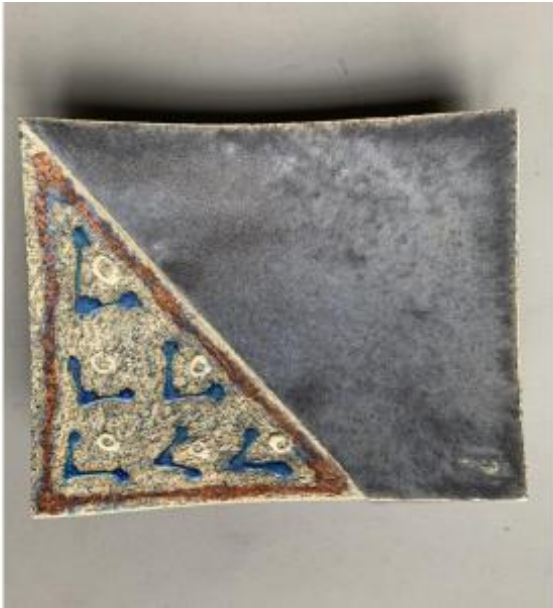




Ceramic Trinket Dish - 1960s

It rests on five small ceramic feet. The decoration, rendered in a palette of anthracite gray, deep blue, brown, and cream, is enlivened at one of the corners by a triangular motif composed of small stylized forms evoking botanical or abstract patterns. The contrast between the dark surface and the colorful decoration lends the piece a decidedly modernist aesthetic. The piece features a slightly grainy enamel, characteristic of certain decorative ceramic works from the period, with an interesting interplay of textures and reliefs. A
