Description

A trefoil-ended brass or patinated metal cross inset with fine polychrome glass micromosaic tesserae. The upper arm features the inscription "ROMA" and the "INRI" titulus. The horizontal arm depicts the Dove of the Holy Spirit flanked by Alpha and Omega (A-?). The vertical stem displays the Instruments of the Passion (Arma Christi), including floral patterns, dice, pincers, a ladder, and a hammer. Italy, Rome. Late 19th or early 20th century. Very good overall condition. Produced primarily in Rome as devotional souvenirs for pilgrims and travelers on the Grand Tour, these micromosaic crosses highlight the exceptional craftsmanship of Italian glass mosaic workshops.
