Flared cut crystal vase, clear with ruby red overlay (cristal doublé). Features diamond-cut geometric patterns on the central body, pointed panel cuts along the flared upper rim, a faceted lower section, and a hexagonal short stem over a circular foot. France. Baccarat. VAL SAINT-LAMBERT 19th century. Height: 18 cm / Upper diameter: 9.5 cm / Base diameter: 9.5 cm. Good condition. In 19th-century Europe, overlay crystal (cristal doublé) was produced by fusing a layer of colored glass over clear lead crystal before cutting geometric motifs into the outer layer. This technique was widely practiced by renowned French crystal manufacturers such as Baccarat and Saint-Louis, as well as Bohemian glassmakers.
