The work features a cobblestone alley leading to a fortified gate with a pointed arch topped by a square tower, opening onto a body of water in the background. Remarkable work in terms of perspective, the rendering of textures, and the play of light on the stone. Dimensions: 36x49 cm. Born in Ligny-en-Barrois (Meuse) in 1882, Émile Gallois was a painter and artist from Lorraine. He exhibited notably at the Salon de Nancy and the Salon des Indépendants in Paris. Recognized for his talent as a draftsman and his knowledge of cultural heritage, he specialized in architectural illustration, regional landscapes, and the documentation of local traditions.

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
