17th-century Flemish School. Oil on mahogany panel depicting a scene of peasant revelry featuring 12 figures engaged in various activities and expressions of joy. A follower of Mattheus VAN HELMONT. Panel dimensions: 54 x 40 cm. 19th-century frame in wood and gilded stucco with a patina, in the Louis XV style. Overall dimensions: 73 x 60 cm. Mattheus VAN HELMONT (1623-1779), a Flemish painter specializing in interior and village scenes. His favorite subjects were influenced by David Teniers the Younger and Adriaen Brouwer. Visible panel reinforcement on the back.
