Description

A Louis XVI-era clock, signed by the famous Parisian clockmaker Cronier, made of white marble and mercury-gilded bronze. Richly ornamented, magnificent 24-digit enamel dial signed in red by the clockmaker, with a pair of period mercury hands. Large string movement, serviced by a clockmaker with pendulum and keys, asymmetrical winding mechanisms, and a very beautiful half-hour chime on a bell. (Photos 11 and 12). Original double pedestal secured by the two legs (threaded rods) on the left and right; the other three legs rest in three holes on the base of the pedestal.
