SPECC559 - Mirror in blue and gold lacquered wood. Carved with side columns, symbolizing Aesculapius and the Caduceus. The Rod of Asclepius is the symbol of medicine and healing and is a sign of peace represented by a staff with two outstretched wings and two intertwined serpents facing each other. The Caduceus is interpreted as a representation of the god himself and is one of the oldest symbols in the history of human civilization. At the base are carved flowers, a harp, and a cornucopia: symbols of prosperity and fertility. Dated to the 18th century. Dimensions: L 55 x H 113 cm
