Description

Oil on canvas depicting a lively scene in front of Caernarfon (or Carnarvon) Castle in North Wales, by William Raymond Dommersen, an English painter born in London in 1859 and who died there in 1927. Signed and inscribed with the location on the back of the canvas. Good condition ; note a small restoration in the sky area on the left. Dimensions : 38 x 28 cm. William Raymond Dommersen was the son of the Anglo-Dutch artist Pieter Cornelis Dommersen and Anna Petronella Synja, who had moved from the Netherlands to London in 1855. W. R. Dommersen painted high-quality genre scenes, landscapes, seascapes, and village and town scenes. His best-known works depict European villages and towns situated along rivers and canals. He painted primarily in the Netherlands
