PAUL BOREL (1828-1913) -- FIGURE STUDY A beautiful original graphite drawing on paper, signed "Paul Borel" in the lower right corner, depicting a male figure in a study of movement and anatomy. Paul Borel, born in Lyon in 1828 and died in 1913, was a leading artist of the 19th-century Lyon School. A student of Louis Janmot, he is best known for his religious paintings and large-scale murals. His work as a draftsman played a significant role in his body of work. The Musée des Beaux-Arts de Lyon holds a collection of several hundred drawings from his studio, including numerous preparatory studies. The drawing presented here, with its rapid and expressive treatment of the figure, reflects this practice of preparatory drawing. Technique: graphite on paper Signature: Paul Borel, lower
