Description

- 17th-century-style oak table with a drawer, a 19th-century Belgian piece. - Oak table resting on four legs composed of cubes and wide, vase-shaped sections (with a curved profile). The tops of the legs are adorned with carved half-balls, while the crossbars feature delicately carved interlacing motifs; on the central friezes, the center of each motif is embellished with a flower, and the corners are adorned with fluted moldings. The table features a front drawer adorned with a key lock and is topped by a tabletop whose outline is accentuated by carved oblong leaf motifs. - This 19th-century model, remarkable for the quality of its carving and its highly decorative aesthetic, is comparable to 17th-century furniture from the Flemish Netherlands, as evidenced by certain examples
