The armrests, with padded cuffs, rest on sinuous armrests, adorned with carved plant motifs. The front legs are adorned with carved rosettes, while the tapered, fluted legs end in molded feet. The seat panels are also highlighted by molding and carved decorative motifs, contributing to the overall elegance of the set. The armchairs retain their fabric upholstery featuring a geometric pattern of small medallions in shades of beige and cream,
