School of Jean-Marc Nattier. Important oil on canvas depicting the presumed portrait of Madame de Fesselles. This painting depicts a young woman in the guise of a nymph leaning against an urn from which water gushes, while reeds appear behind her. She is seated in a landscape, her body draped in a wide piece of mauve fabric. The very low neckline, puffed sleeves, and blue bow are characteristic of mid-18th-century aristocratic fashion. The face is rendered with the softness, fair complexion, and calm, slightly distant expression characteristic of Nattier's work. Louis XV period, 18th century
