Description

A very rare Limoges enamel serving platter that makes a beautiful centerpiece. This exceptional serving set, known as a "sweet dish," consists of three plates of different diameters stacked in three tiers. It rests on a lovely gilded bronze base in the Rocaille style and is topped with a loop-shaped handle. Each dish is adorned along its rim with a beautiful design of arabesques, orange cabochons, and white pearls against a brown-orange background. This magnificent piece was created in the workshops of René Bonhomme (1927-2007), a master enameleer in Limoges known for the exceptional quality of his work. Each bowl bears the gold-colored signature of R. Bonhomme on its reverse side, along with the inscription "Emaux d'art - Limoges." Dimensions: height 41 cm diameter of
