Description

Large Art Nouveau (Jugendstil) planter made of glazed terracotta (majolica), Model 1002, designed by the German painter and ceramicist Wilhelm Süss (1861-1933) for the prestigious Großherzogliche Majolika-Manufaktur Karlsruhe. Oval in shape, the basin--featuring relief decoration simulating wickerwork--is draped with a rich garland of flowers and blue forget-me-nots. It is supported at each end by four putti resting on a terrace resembling a grassy lawn dotted with flowers. The glaze has a superb sheen with magnificent shades of green, blue, and cream characteristic of early 20th-century German productions. Very good condition. No chips. Slight marbling and some wear on the glaze inside the planter (see photo). Dimensions: 33 cm by 17 cm and 24.5 cm high.
