Swiss Infantry Sword, Type 1831/52. Symmetrical, one-piece brass-cast hilt with a grip featuring 25 ridges. Blade with a central groove on both sides, 48.8 cm long, marked " F. HÖRSTER SOLINGEN ". Leather scabbard with brass fittings and its original scabbard holder in good condition. Total length 66.5 cm. The absence of other markings indicates that this is a so-called "officer's private purchase" item.- Direct purchase by an officer or a military unit: Under the former Swiss military organization, some soldiers or officers purchased their own equipment from private suppliers who imported blades directly from Solingen, bypassing the official inspection and marking process of the cantonal arsenal.
