Description

Small cabaret table with a fixed cherry wood top -- Louis XV period France, probably La Rochelle, 18th century Solid cherry wood -- fixed top with beveled edges A very pretty small Louis XV-era cabaret table, likely made in the La Rochelle region, notable for the elegant simplicity of its construction and the magnificent quality of its wood. It features a wide, fixed top made of solid cherry wood, of a generous thickness, with a surface displaying a particularly rich and warm grain. The tabletop is beveled at all four corners, while its perimeter is accented by an elegant molded and slightly raised rim, characteristic of cabaret tables designed to hold objects placed on their surface. The beauty of this table lies in particular in its antique cherry wood, whose honey, amber, and reddish-brown hues are

especially deep. The marks and small irregularities visible in the wood bear witness to its past use and fully contribute to its charm. The modestly molded apron opens at the front to reveal a drawer, adding extra functionality to this small table. Its lower section is accentuated by a scalloped line, with gentle curves that blend seamlessly into the design. The piece rests on four curved legs, with an elegant and dynamic line, ending in small scroll feet, characteristic of the Louis XV style. The carving is deliberately understated: no excessive ornamentation, but a constant pursuit of fluidity between the apron, the legs, and the tabletop. The regional character of this table is particularly interesting. Its proportions, the choice of cherry wood, and the simplicity of its decoration naturally evoke furniture from western France, particularly 18th-century pieces from La Rochelle. Its deliberately compact size and its fixed tabletop with a rim are perfectly suited to its use as a small side table: whether as a side table, a coffee table, or a serving table, it could easily be placed next to an armchair or a sofa. Restored in our workshops, it has retained its antique character, its beautiful wood grain, and its warm patina. A particularly charming little table, whose appeal lies entirely in the quality of the wood, the precision of its proportions, and the elegance of its Louis XV-style curves. A charming regional piece, as decorative as it is functional, that will naturally find its place in both traditional interiors and more contemporary decor. A very beautiful little cabaret table, authentic and warm, whose simplicity is precisely what gives it its elegance. Dimensions: to be specified. Louis XV period, 18th century.
