Description

A wonderfully decorative mid-20th-century glazed ceramic lidded jar, distinguished by its vibrant yellow ground and charming hand-painted decoration of stylized roosters and hens. The cylindrical body is arranged in a series of framed panels, each featuring a different bird rendered with great character and imagination. Stripes, spots and almost leopard-like markings give the chickens a wonderfully playful appearance, while the warm red, blue, green, black and cream tones stand out beautifully against the luminous yellow glaze. A geometric trellis border punctuated with small green leaf motifs surrounds each panel, giving the composition a particularly graphic quality. The removable lid continues the decoration with a further hand-painted rooster, making the piece attractive from every angle.

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Slight variations in the painted lines and individual motifs lend the jar the appealing character of hand decoration rather than a mechanically uniform finish. With its generous proportions and strong color, this ceramic jar would make a striking decorative accent in a kitchen, dining room or interior collection, either displayed alone or combined with other colorful ceramics.
