The impassive figure, chin resting on a powerfully defined hand, embodies a majestic introspection. The carved wooden base enhances the nobility of the piece as a whole, providing a warm pedestal for this meditative silhouette that commands attention with quiet strength. The work expresses Chiparus's artistic maturity, blending classical elegance and emotional depth in harmonious

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continuity. The work is signed "-DH Chiparus-" and stamped "-BRONZE PARIS-". Demétre Haralamb Chiparus (1886-1947) was a major Art Deco sculptor, born in Romania and based in Paris from 1912 onward, where he trained at the École des Beaux-Arts. Active primarily between 1914 and 1933, he became famous for his chryselephantine sculptures inspired by the Ballets Russes, music hall, and ancient Egypt.
