This Napoleon III display cabinet features an elegant cherry wood frame, whose warm natural grain is enhanced by finely crafted rosewood marquetry. It is topped by a superb Carrara marble panel with recessed corners, lending it a noble and sculptural presence typical of the Second Empire. The front, punctuated by two glass doors, reveals a bright interior ideal for displaying precious objects, while the molded frame highlights the finesse of the woodworking. The piece is enhanced by bronze hardware, including lock plates, latches, shoes, and a chiseled key; its fully functional lock attests to the piece's integrity and authenticity. The base rests on blackened wooden spindle legs with gilded collars, creating a subtle contrast with the warm hue of the cherry wood and enhancing the
