It is fitted with two chiseled knobs whose classic rounded shape and subtle sheen evoke the decorative codes of the era, adding a touch of nobility without ostentation. The front columns, true hallmarks of the Empire style, stand with a sculptural presence. They are adorned with chiseled rings and a finely crafted collar--metallic details that emphasize the piece's verticality while affirming its aristocratic character. These delicately crafted ornaments bear witness to the craftsmanship of 19th-century artisans and lend

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the piece a solemn yet harmonious air. The perfectly proportioned lower shelf forms a solid base and provides additional display or storage space, while reinforcing the stability of the entire piece.
