Description

The dynamically shaped shafts rest on a polylobed base with scalloped edges, adorned with rich high-relief decoration featuring shells, volutes, rocaille scrolls, acanthus leaves, small flowers, and asymmetrical medallions. Each baluster shaft, with curved sides, is entirely adorned with contoured volutes, leaf-shaped clasps, and rocaille cartouches in slight relief. It extends into a twisted central knot from which a six-armed cluster of light indouble volutes soars, arranged around a central candlestick, forming a particularly airy composition. Each arm, with an undulating cross-section, is adorned with veined acanthus leaves, jagged volutes, and plant-inspired scrollwork. The fixed candle holders, shaped like fluted corollas, rest on molded bases decorated with foliage motifs. The entire piece, entirely cast,

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chiseled, and reworked with a burin, exemplifies the revival of the Louis XV style during the Second Empire, characterized by a perfect mastery of volume, great finesse in chiseling, and deeply sculpted decoration.
