The lioness is depicted with power and realism, with particular attention paid to her musculature, head, and legs. The traces of the hand-modeling are clearly visible in the fur and on the base, giving the piece a lively and unique character. The sculpture is clearly signed "Ch. Gréber" on the side of the rectangular base. This signature corresponds to Charles Gréber (1853-1935), a famous French ceramicist based in Beauvais.
