The pear-shaped body against a cream background is entirely adorned with a rich polychrome floral design, composed of roses, tulips, and small flowers in shades of red, pink, yellow, blue, and green. The widely flared neck is highlighted by a green border and extends into a flowing spout. The spectacular openwork handle, designed in the Rocaille style, consists of modeled volutes and foliage accented with nuanced green enamel. The fluted base features the same motif of acanthus leaves and scrolls in relief, with small floral accents. The enamel displays a fine crackle pattern, which adds to the piece's decorative
