Chinese Ming Wanli 'Kraak' Blue and White 'Klapmuts' Bowl c.1620 China, Ming dynasty, Wanli reign, c.1600-1620 Diameter 15.3 cm Height: 5.3 cm Beautiful bowl of the first decades of the seventeenth century, made during the late Ming dynasty under the Wanli Emperor, also known as 'Kraak' porcelain. Amusing and freely painted typical Kraak decoration of panels and Taotie masks with a central design of a landscape with a bird on a rock, known as a 'Kraaikom' in Dutch. The general shape of the bowl is known as 'klapmuts'. Good condition for the age, some small firing imperfections in the glaze and three hairlines to the rim. Shipping in Europe: EUR 25
