The elegant platinum setting, typical of high-end jewelry from the early 20th century, features a refined openwork pattern on the shoulders and is embellished with single-cut natural diamonds totaling approximately 0.20 carats. The setting's structure perfectly frames the central stone, while the small diamonds add brilliance without detracting from
