A stunning mid-century Danish ceramic table lamp, designed by Arne Finne Nielsen and manufactured by Soholm in Denmark in the 1960s-1970s. The lamp features a sculptural glazed ceramic base adorned with an expressive geometric pattern in rich shades of blue, warm ochre, and natural terracotta--colors characteristic of the distinctive aesthetic of Danish studio ceramics from that era. The rounded, organic shape offers a magnificent contrast to the graphic motifs, giving the piece a presence that is both strong and elegant. The lamp is signed and still bears its original model number, 3077-3, which reinforces its authenticity and collectible value. An exceptional example of a mid-century Danish ceramic lamp, combining sculptural form, hand-finished decoration, and functional design.
