He wears a dark blue uniform with a collar embroidered with large silver pomegranates, pomegranate-shaped buttons, an epaulet, a counter-epaulet, and a silver-trimmed aiguillette. The subject is decorated with the Legion of Honor as well as the Lily, a distinction created during the Restoration, illustrating the continuity of military careers following the fall of the Empire and the return of the Bourbon monarchy. This portrait exemplifies the elegance and restraint characteristic of French military portraiture from the first third of the 19th

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century. Presented in its original carved and gilded wooden frame.
