Large mirror with wooden frame moldings and gilded stucco from the Napoleon III period. Mirror featuring a candlestick on each side of the top molding and, in the center, a bouquet of flowers with a quiver and two doves. The sides are carved with a ribbon entwined with bouquets of flowers. Acanthus leaves are applied at the bottom. The glazing bead mirrors are adorned with fleurs-de-lis. The central mirror has a slightly discolored surface. A few missing pieces at the bottom of the frame. Very beautiful overall effect. H: 174 cm W: 107 cm D: 14 cm. Central mirror: 119.5 x 64.5 cm.
