A violin from the Mirecourt workshop, a model by Jean Baptiste Vuillaume dating from 1900-1920, bearing the label of the Jean Baptiste Vuillaume workshop at 3 rue Demours-Ternes in Paris, reflecting the inspiration of classical models and the craftsmanship of Mirecourt, which guarantees the instrument's authenticity and historical value; ideal for musicians seeking an instrument with character. Back length: 359 mm Rich flamed maple with inlaid fillets, rosewood pegs, and ebony fingerboard and tailpiece. The instrument comes with two octagonal violin bows, one of which is a beautiful silver-mounted example. It is generally accepted that more than three thousand instruments were produced in the workshop of Jean-Baptiste Vuillaume (1798-1875).
