Origin: Liège, Belgium (Official ELG hallmark in an oval without a crown on the barrel, indicating manufacture between 1846 and 1893). Mechanism functional the percussion is crisp. Barrel: Octagonal barrel in polished steel, with beautiful, sharp edges. Stock: Very beautiful carved wooden stock with longitudinal fluting. The wood is sound, with a magnificent period patina. Accessory: Original wooden cleaning rod present beneath the barrel. Regulatory Status: Historical and collector's firearm classified as Category D (firing mechanism predating
