Louis XVI-era armchair with a flat, oval backrest, stamped CJYM. Elegant Louis XVI-era armchair in waxed wood, molded and carved. Armrests with cuffs. Flower-decorated connecting blocks; the seat rests on tapered, fluted, and serrated legs. The armchair is upholstered in a fabric with floral motifs and red and cream stripes (as is). Spring-supported upholstery. Beautiful proportions and sound structure. The mark CJYM (C·JY·M), long attributed to the Nantes cabinetmaker Claude Javoy, may also be attributed to the Parisian sculptor Charles Joigny (1731-1803). The latter regularly collaborated with chairmakers, and this mark is often affixed as a secondary stamp alongside those of the great masters of the era...I invite you to read the interesting article on the French Chair on this
