Description

A striking Dutch Jugendstil cabinet in solid quarter-sawn oak, crafted between 1900 and 1910 and showcasing the refined architectural language of early Amsterdamse School design. The cabinet's vertical composition is both functional and sculptural: a paneled upper cupboard with geometric brass escutcheons, an open central display section, and a lower cupboard echoing the same disciplined detailing. The four corner posts are turned and ringed, rising above the top as small finials that lend the piece a distinctive silhouette. At the crown sits a beautifully carved butterfly motif, a subtle organic detail characteristic of Dutch Art Nouveau craftsmanship. The quarter-sawn oak displays lively medullary rays and a warm, original patina that has developed gracefully over more than a

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century. Structurally sound and well-preserved, the cabinet shows only minor wear consistent with age and use. It forms a matching pair with reference 26-0075, photographed together as a harmonious suite. A refined and authentic example of Dutch Jugendstil, ideal for collectors and interiors seeking sculptural lines, historical craftsmanship, and warm natural materials.
