Its rich, sophisticated design centers on a large floral medallion in sumptuous shades of red, burgundy, powder pink, ivory, and beige, accented with touches of blue and brown. The field is filled with an abundance of delicately drawn scrolls, flowers, foliage, and arabesques, arranged in a classic Persian composition. A series of fine floral borders frames the design, featuring a striking deep-red main border richly adorned
