Description

0A beautiful oil-on-canvas painting depicting a market scene in Limoges. The painting is signed in the lower left corner by Louis Peyrat, a painter from Saint-Germain-les-Belles in the Haute-Vienne department (87). A charming depiction of a small market of the kind still seen in the first half of the 20th century. Our painting depicts a greengrocer in front of his stall. The colors are exceptionally vibrant, and the painting is in perfect condition. Dimensions: frame 65 cm x 76 cm canvas 50 cm x 61 cm Louis Peyrat (1911-1999), a French painter born on November 30, 1911, in La Gorceix, Saint-Germain-Les-Belles, near Limoges. He completed an apprenticeship in carpentry; at the same time, he studied by correspondence at the École Universelle. After passing its entrance

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exam, he worked at an architecture firm in Limoges. In his spare time, he attended the School of Decorative Arts in Limoges; then, beginning in 1934, he devoted himself to painting. In 1948, he exhibited at the Magadoux Gallery in Limoges, then in Royan and at numerous other galleries. Beginning in 1958, he painted views of Paris--particularly of Montmartre--which brought him success. He gained admission to the highly renowned Cercle Volney and to Parisian galleries such as the Roussard Gallery. His paintings were exhibited alongside those of Degas, Derain, Domergue, Buffet, Braque, Picasso, Foujita, Utrillo, Laurencin, and others.....until 1969, the year in which he stopped painting due to complications resulting from a traffic accident he had suffered a few years earlier (1963). His success allowed him to live comfortably until his death on March 13, 1999, at Le Martoulet in Saint-Germain-Les-Belles. Please contact us regarding shipping costs.
